That's why for Eurocamp18 we have selected a catering company that is used to cooking for massive outdoor events, including the 2012 London Olympics, large music festivals, major businesses, and a whole variety of fairs and shows. They understand the importance of food in a successful event, and are partnering us to deliver just what we need.

Where will food be served?

The Eurocamp18 site has a large building normally used at agricultural shows, and this will become the Eurocamp18 dining room, which will seat up to 800 people at a time. Food will be served in a number of sittings.

This room will also be used to house the coffee shop, and as one of the venues for evening entertainment, and as the home of the adults bar - The George and Dragon.


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What will be on the menu?

Breakfast

Every day there will be a selection including

- Ham & Cheese Croissant
- Porridge with a selection of Jams or Honey
- Salami selection, Emmental cheese, white or brown Bloomer bread or baguette
- Fruit selection of banana, apple or orange
- All of the above served with either tea or coffee

Lunch

- Jacket Potato with cheese, beans, coleslaw or tuna
- Pasta Choice: chicken or vegetable with a daily selection of sauce (tomato & basil, spicy arrabiatta or mushroom)
- Soup and a roll (tomato, country vegetable or broccoli & stilton)
- Self serve salad bar
- Selection of fruit

A packed lunch will be provided on hike and trips days

Evening Meal

Each day there will be four different meals to choose from, the options will include:

- Gourmet burgers and chips
- A noodle bar
- Spicy Meatballs and pasta
- Chicken Tikka Curry with rice or chips
- Spaghetti Bolognaise
- Chicken Madras with rice or chips

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- Sausage Casserole
- Chicken Korma with rice or chips

- Beef Lasagne with rice or chips
- Chinese Chicken Curry with rice or chips
