Here we are! This year, as you probably know, the WFIS Workshop will be located this year in Madrid - Spain. We have chosen a very special place for all those who know the Spanish culture, Alcalá de Henares. The birthplace of Miguel de Cervantes, writer of one of the most famous and most published books in the world "Don Quixote de la Mancha".

ASIM (Asociacion de Scouts Independientes de Madrid) invite you to share and enjoy this event with us, and we hope the activities offered are not just good fun but, also useful.

If you are interested in this event and would like to assist, please to register fill and send us the **REGISTRATION FORM** (available in this doc) before **September 14**, **2018** to **workshop.madrid18@gmail.com**. Once your application document arrives, a confirmation letter, with further details, will be sent to you.

The workshop participation fee is € 65 per person, including all expenses related to lodging, food (since dinner on Friday to breakfast on Sunday) and materials for the workshops. Make sure you pay the correct amount to the bank account, according to the number of the participants from your association, and indicate "Workshop Madrid" as reference.

At the end of the workshop, when you return to your countries, we would like you to be able to apply our workshops with your kids. The workshop will be divided in 3 days: Friday (Reception), Saturday (Workshops) and Sunday (Scout Market, exchange of badges and farewell).

Friday (November, 2nd): Welcome day.

Saturday (November, 3rd): You will be able to move around the different organized workshops combined with the touristic and cultural tour in the morning and afternoon.

As a cultural tour we have organized a route through Alcalá de Henares walking in its streets and most emblematic places. Two turns will be organized, one in the morning and the other in the afternoon.

In the evening we would like to spend some quality time together, singing and sharing stories about our groups. You can carry your own musical instruments to participate.

Sunday (November 4th): After breakfast there will be a small scout market, where you will have the chance to buy objects from the different groups and swap badges. During the morning we will celebrate the Closing Ceremony and take a group photo.

Expressly, we have prepared some interesting activities you could learn and reproduce at home with your own sections. Use the form at the end of this information to select which workshop you and/or your Scout Group or Association you will do, among those that are offered here:

- Leather work: easy and simple leather sewing and cutting techniques to produce nice knife cases, bags
 or other traditional handcrafted scout complements that you will carry back to home as example. This is
 not particularly recommended for, so will be useful for cubs, scouts, senior scouts, and rovers sections.
- 2. Workshop wheel: eight simple manual works with which to take advantage of materials to recycle and create key rings, ornate pen, Christmas decorations, among others. Highly recommended for the beavers of the colony and the cubs packs.
- 3. **Recycling blacksmith**: recycle and reuse useless tools from the auto garage to create your own ax, knife, or scout utensils. This is particularly recommended for, scouts, senior scouts and rovers sections.
- 4. **Cantoya balloon sky-lantern**: prepare a paper balloon, filled with the hot air from a wick, to ascend and carry your desires to the blue sky. Nice for This is particularly recommended for, scouts, senior scout and rovers sections.
- 5. **Recycling and bushcraft knitting, your baldric**: Use old shirts to learn to knit with your own needles carved in wood. You can have your own baldric useful to carry the patrol flagpoles (i.e.). And from there, weave what you can think of. This is particularly recommended for, scouts, senior scout and rovers sections.
- 6. **Paracord bracelets**: if you like knots, this is the best way to carry meters and meters of nylon rope in a simple and elegant way. Design your bracelet with threads and different finishes. This is not particularly recommended for, so will be useful for any section.
- 7. **Carving candles**: with the original products create your own color candle and learn to carve figures in the wax. This is particularly recommended for, scouts, senior scout and rovers sections.
- 8. **Gazpacho**: typical Spanish veggie cold soup. This is not particularly recommended for, so will be useful for cubs, scouts, senior scouts, and rovers sections.
- 9. **Churros**: typical Spanish fried dough and sweet. This is not particularly recommended for, so will be useful for cubs, scouts, senior scouts, and rovers sections.
- Guided visit to Alcala de Henares: in which the most emblematic historical places of the city will be visited.

The final Saturday timetable will be presented at the workshop place, and will be arranged according the most demanded activities. We presume cover all your expectations providing the possibility to pass from side to side of the activities.

Some important information to prepare your trip to the workshop.

Location of the Workshop: "Albergue la Esgaravita" (Alcalá de Henares).

If you arrive Madrid by plane: go to T4 airport terminal. There you will find the train station with When you buy the ticket, select Atocha station as your destiny.



How to travel by train:

In **ATOCHA** station you can choose the C2 or C7 line of *Cercanias* to the ALCALA DE HENARES station. When leaving the station, you can take the Bus (L5) that has a bus stop in front of the inn. Another way is go to the ALCALA UNIVERSIDAD station(only if you take the C2 line) and walk to the inn (more o less 15min) *IMPORTANT* Both trains (C2 and C7) use the same railway. Check the number of the train and the stops on the information panels.

How to travel by bus (green buses):

From **AVENIDA DE AMÉRICA** transport station, take the "Continental Auto" bus (no. 221) to Guadalajara (destiny). You have to get off the bus in the La Dehesa Shopping Center, and walk a couple of minutes to the inn. Tell to the bus driver where you get off (Centro commercial La Dehesa)

Additionally, you can go to ATOCHA or AVENIDA DE AMERICA by subway (tube) from the airport, also.




