He did not do this to get honour and glory, nor to get half the kingdom and the princess promised as a reward to whoever could slay the dragon, he did it because it was the right thing to do and he rode on into the world without claiming his reward.

In doing so, he came to stand as a role model and a symbol of some of the things that we as scouts should stand for, courage, strength, orderliness, honesty, and doing what is right, without expecting to get something for doing it.

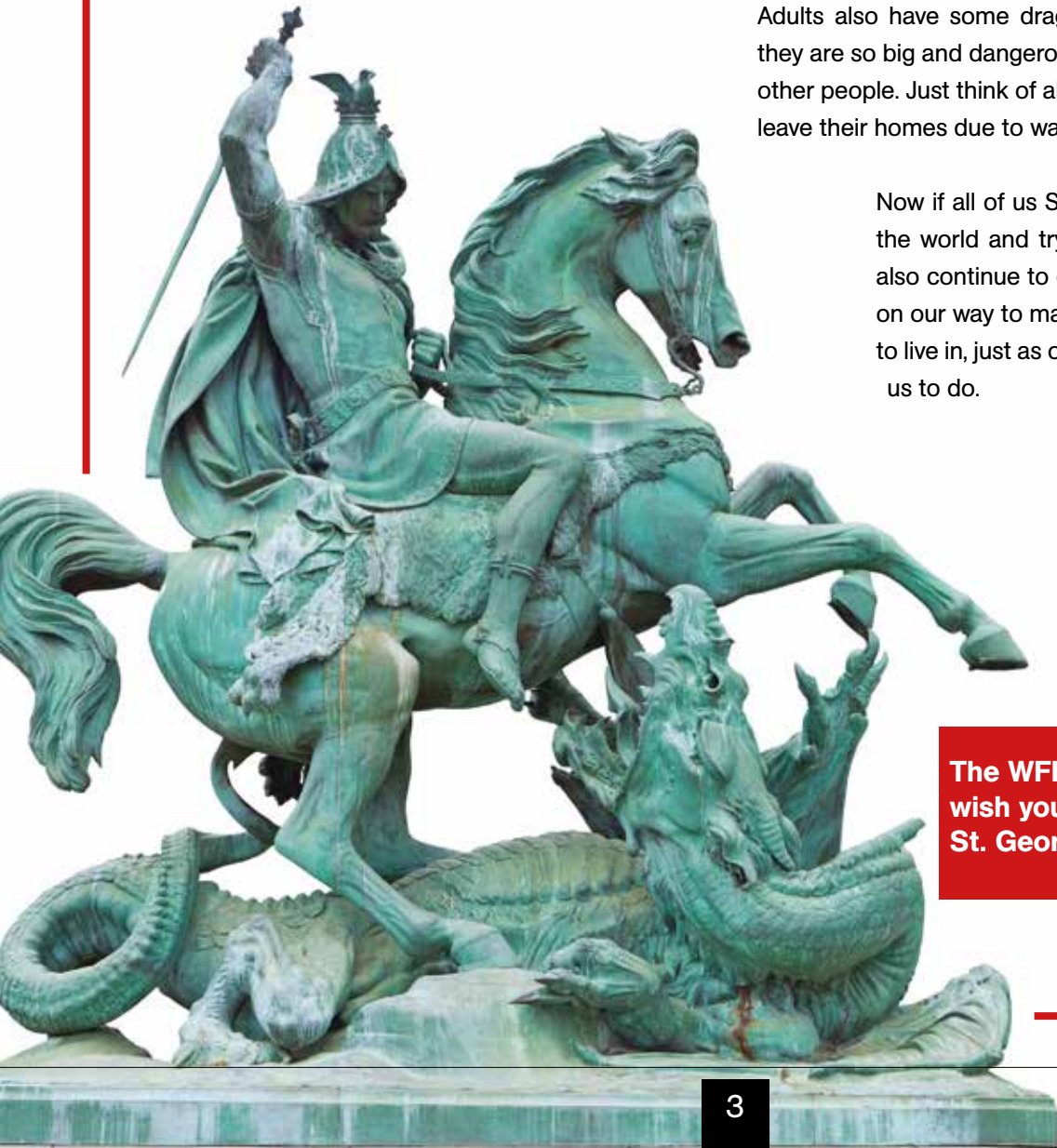

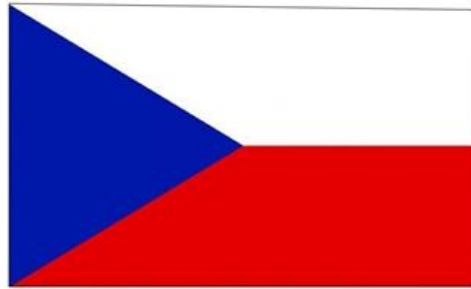

REFORESTATION OF BURNT AREAS

On the 14th of January 2023 in Pedro Bernardo (Avila), a village in Spain, a reforestation of areas burnt in the last summers was organised.

This village has had four big fires in the last 30 years. But the Asociación Vecinal Pedro Bernardo Siempre Verde and the Plataforma Planta Un Árbol Scout organised this activity.

More than 170 scouts from Grupo Scout Nómadas (WFIS), Grupo Scout Hotara (WFIS) and Grupo Scout Tomahawk (ORUS) participated in this activity.

The activity was divided into two parts. The first part of the activity was in the morning where all volunteers were divided into three groups: the Beavers did a seed bomb workshop following the „Nendo Dango“ method, for future reforestation. The Cubs did the Bernaldo Bear route

where they sowed seeds and saw what a varied forest of autochthonous species looks like and finally the Scouts and Rovers did the planting of leafy species such as chestnut, rowan, ash, arraclan, kerquiaceae such as oak, holm oak, cork oak, gall oak and other shrub species such as cornicabra, strawberry tree, or holly in an area conditioned and protected with a fence against herbivores, created specifically to ensure the survival of the species planted.

A natural encounter that has served to form a mixed forest which, when it matures, will be a point from which the seeds will spread and expand the species that form it, thus recovering and increasing the biodiversity of the forest. After lunch, the activity was completed with

a photographic gymkhana around the village where the Scout groups were able to walk around and get to know some of the most characteristic places of the Balcón del Tiétar.

This activity was very appreciated by all and even appeared in several digital and printed newspapers of the province.

JORNADA DE REFORESTACIÓN EN EL MONTE CUCHARERO

Unas 170 personas de los Grupos de Scouts de Madrid Tomahawk, Nómadas y Hotara participan en una jornada impulsada por la Asociación Vecinal Pedro Bernardo Siempre Verde

La Asociación Vecinal Pedro Bernardo Siempre Verde celebró este pasado sábado la primera de varias jornadas de reforestación programadas para los meses de enero y febrero. En esta primera cita se organizó una jornada de reforestación en colaboración con la Plataforma Ganadora junto con la Plataforma un Árbol por grupo de Scouts de Madrid Tomahawk, Nómadas y Hotara, de edades comprendidas entre los 3 y los 22 años, todos ellos acompañados de monitores y padres.

Llegaron sobre las 11 de la mañana al paraje del Mercedero, donde estaba prevista que se realizarán todas las actividades. Allí se les dio la bienvenida por parte de la asociación Siempre Verde y una pequeña explicación de los incendios sufridos en el paraje que iban a realizar ese día, ya que los scouts no forman parte de la naturaleza y dejaron

su aportación en el monte de Pedro Bernardo sembrando semillas de árboles. Tras esta explicación, se distribuyeron por la montaña, se les entregó a cada uno un tipo de semilla, recordando todo tipo de semillas, cargadas en sus mochilas o bolsas, para hacer un agujerito y plantarlas, para hacer un agujerito en un pequeño arbol para que en la tierra, con el tiempo, con el apoyo y deseo de que en pocos años nazca un árbol que sirva de protección a las especies implantadas.

Paralelamente a la plantación, también se organizó un taller de bombas de semillas. No sólo se dio a conocer el uso de bombas de semillas en este tipo de proyectos, sino que se formaron grupos de bomberos, utilizando al machacar semillas, sustituir y así las bombas de semillas como para utilizarlas en los proyectos. Las bombas de semillas se utilizaron en la jornada de reforestación para que se sembrara en el monte natural con el objetivo de proteger la biodiversidad y a aumentar la biodiversidad.

Los grupos de Scouts tuvieron la oportunidad de hacer el recorrido por el paraje de la zona, un ejemplo de lo que se puede hacer en los próximos años con estas jornadas de reforestación con especies diversas que van a ser un ejemplo de gestión con el medio natural por el programa se completó con una gimkana fotográfica por el paraje con la que los grupos de

Scouts pudieron recorrer y conocer algunos de los lugares más característicos del Baúlito del Tietar, como el parque de El Bolo, donde se encuentra el monumento del escultor cucharero Arturo Dupret. El Ayuntamiento de Pedro Bernardo, la Agrupación San Pedro Advíncula o la Casa de los Martines.

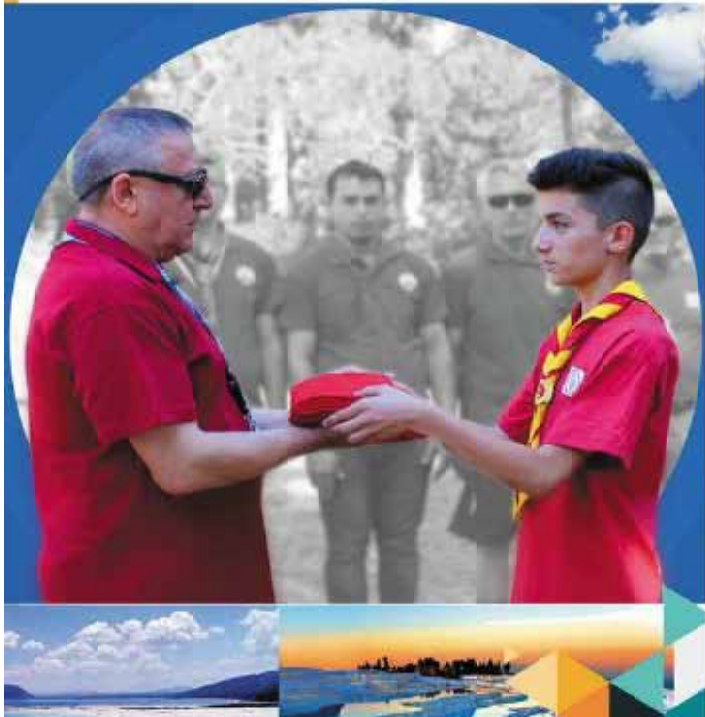

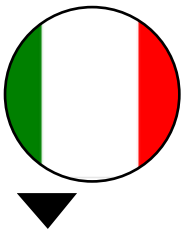

】 The future associations that may want to get registrate in Catalonia must be part of this federation. If not, they are illegal.

Let's take the pill..

And there comes the BIG question we wonder after we read the text:

Does REALLY the government take as theirs a universal methodology, which isn't local, nor regional, nor Spanish... UNIVERSAL and claim an ONLY federation as true, real and genuine scouts in the whole community?

It looks they can. We follow the scout law, the one promulgated by Baden Powell. In so many countries, the 4th law says: "The scout is everybody's friend and brother of other scouts". Is it possible, the ones this Federation has lost this article? May it be erased by a kind of magic? Or it may be changed by government laws...

As a first thought, the public opinion (the non-scouts related) will feel there are real and fake scouts. And since we have not the luck of having catacombs like our roman brothers do, we are going to have to do our activities lost in the fields. Well, let me tell you this is NOT going to happen.

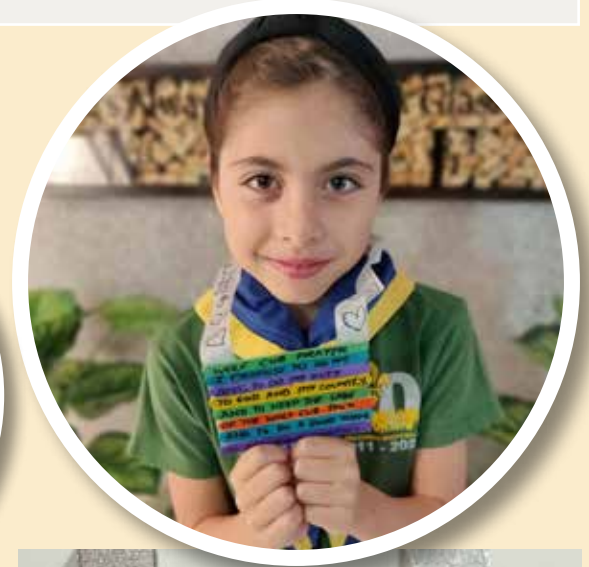

PIONET... 2023



- ▶ **It's for all European Patrols**
- ▶ **2 phases** in which the Patrols will be evaluated
- ▶ the Patrols will have to work very hard to win!

PIONET... is a pioneering competition for Patrols, with complex and elaborate pioneering constructions, with an adequate design, a perfect technical realization and an equally important presentation of the construction.

The final result will be the sum of the work of the Patrols, so the report will have to show in particular the contribution that each Scout has given.

THE ACTIVITY SHOULD BE DEVIDED INTO TWO PHASES:

1 First phase: each Patrol must do a complete design of the structure and calculation of the materials and a report in English must be submitted, as detailed as possible, by **July 31, 2023**. The report must include the name, a photo and the role of each Scout in the Patrol.

- Each Scout that participated will receive a badge and each Patrol a participation certificate.
