MEDICAL COURSE IN BRNO

t the end of April, a medical course was held for scouters from our Scout association SSSCR after the successful completion of which the participants can become camp medics for recovery events. This forty-hour course is accredited by the Ministry

of Health of the Czech Republic. The course took place from April 28th to May 1st at the medical college (in Brno). The participants learned the duties of a camp medic, how to provide first aid in various situations, how to take care of the sick or how to create or maintain medical documents and much more. However, there were also practical lessons. The participants

pool. And thanks to the equipment, they also learned resuscitation, treatment, and handling of injured people. First aid kit equipment and epidemiology were the other topics of prepared lectures. Those were the days packed with lectures and practical teaching. Now all the participants must do is pass the test, which will be written in the fall. But with our knowledge gained from the course we think we all can pass the test easily.

PILGRIMAGE OF JEVICKO SCOUTS TO IVANCENA ON 21ST-23RD APRIL 2023

his year too, girl scouts and boy scouts from Jevicko went on a pilgrimage to the mound on Ivančena. This time, a total of 22 participants from Jevicko went to Ivancena. We traditionally had our facilities in the Sokol gymnasium in Frydlant nad Ostravici, where we arrived on Friday evening. Until nightfall, other expeditions of scouts from different cities gradually arrived at the Sokol gymnasium, increasing the number of overnight guests to a respectable 160 participants.

The wake-up call at seven o'clock, which was very difficult for some participants, was followed by breakfast and preparation for the ascent. The ceremonial starts at 9:30 started everything and the patrols set off towards

160 girl scouts and boy scouts from the SSSCR and Skaut ABS associations went on a joint pilgrimage to the mound on Ivancena. At this stone mound near Lysa hora in the Beskydy mountains, every year around the feast of St. George Day gathers hundreds of scouts and tramps from all over the Czech Republic and abroad. For 77 years, Ivancena has been a symbol of resistance to totalitarian regimes, a legacy of the past that must be remembered so that the hardships suffered are not forgotten. In support of war-torn Ukraine, Skaut ABS association carried the Ukrainian flag this year.

Everyone gradually reached the mound around two

o'clock, when the ceremonial entry took place. The fallen scouts were remembered together, and then the scouts placed their stones brought from home. The greater part of the pilgrims then left for the return journey. However, there were quite a few persistent ones who continued on and after a while stood on the top of Lysa hora, extending their pilgrimage to 27





km. Overall, the climb was successful, and everything turned out great.

Baden-Powell was the second son of Peter Baden-Powell, 2nd Baron Baden-Powell, and Carine Boardman, inheriting the barony following the death of his elder brother Robert in 2019, and was the grandson of the founder of World Scouting, Robert Baden-Powell, and Olave Baden-Powell.
